#### San Diego Housing Commission Celebrates 77 New Affordable Studios Open in Downtown San Diego for Households with Low Income

The San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC) recently celebrated the grand opening of The Helm, a housing development built in collaboration with Affirmed Housing, SDHC, and other partners. The 77-unit development includes 41 units affordable for individuals with income up to 80 percent of AMI and 4 units for residents with up to 60 percent of AMI. The SDHC awarded 32 federal rental housing vouchers for residents with extremely low income, as well as awarded a loan of approximately \$4.2 million to assist in the development of The Helm. <u>Read more here.</u>

#### Summer Program for City Teens: Counselor-in-Training Project for Chicago Housing Authority Residents

This summer, the Chicago Housing Authority (CHA) has been partnering with the Chicago Park District to host their Counselor-in-Training program. The Counselor-in-Training program is hosted at Chicago Park District sites over a period of six weeks for 15-year-olds who live in CHA housing. During the program, participants receive training in skills such as leadership and financial literacy. <u>Read more here</u>.

#### Delaware State Housing Authority Announces New Program and Partnerships to Address Housing Instability

The Delaware State Housing Authority (DSHA) has recently awarded more than \$800,000 in Housing Outreach and Stability Services (HOSS) grants to five community partner organizations across the state: Central Delaware Habitat for Humanity, Latin American Community Center, Lutheran Community Services, NeighborGood Partners, and West End Neighborhood House. HOSS works to support individuals and families in maintaining housing and achieving housing stability, through methods such as providing connections to services.
