Minneapolis Public Housing Authority Breaks Ground on Historic Public Housing Redevelopment

The vision for the landmark \$78m investment at Spring Manor - the city's largest ever redevelopment effort - is the result of years of work with residents to create a plan that preserves 221 units for older residents across two buildings while also adding 15 new deeply affordable and fully accessible units.

The renovations, which include updates to aging building systems, accessibility upgrades, in-unit cooling and ventilation systems, and exterior enveloping repairs, are made possible by MPHA's ability to bring together public- and private-sector partners while leveraging multiple funding streams in support of their residents and the preservation of affordable housing.

Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority Celebrates SPARK Program Graduates

This month, Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (AMHA) celebrated over 70 young graduates from their Early Childhood Initiative's (ECI) Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids (SPARK) program. SPARK prepares children and families for kindergarten by providing early education math and reading resources, coordinating school tours during the summer months, and having conversations with families around the needs of their children.

Leveraging collaborative partnerships and targeted support, research shows that these initiatives, including specifically AMHA's SPARK program, improve outcomes for young children and their families by promoting health, well-being, and school readiness.
