## Atlanta Housing Breaks Ground on First Phase of Bowen Homes Choice Neighborhoods Redevelopment

Atlanta Housing put shovels in the ground earlier this month to kick off a redevelopment effort sixteen years in the making. Built in northwest Atlanta in 1964, the old Bowen Homes were named after John W. E. Bowen Sr., one of the first African Americans to earn a Ph.D. in the US. One-time home to Evander Holyfield and rapper Shawty Lo, Bowen Homes was demolished in 2009. Supported by a \$40 million HUD Choice Neighborhoods Implementation (CNI) grant award in 2022, the redevelopment of Bowen Homes has garnered over \$523 million in public and private commitments to bring new life to the community including 756 mixed-income housing units, retail, green space, civic amenities, and high-performing schools.
